- 1) [PHIVOLCS-DOST](#) maintains Alert Level 4 for Mount Mayon (hazardous eruption imminent) and the 8-km Permanent Danger Zone (PDZ) remains effective
- 2) Lava fountain, tremors and rockfall were observed on 28 Jan 2018
- 3) Province of Albay, Region V was declared under the State of Calamity thru [Resolution No. 00670-2018](#)
- 4) AHA Centre is closely monitoring the situation
