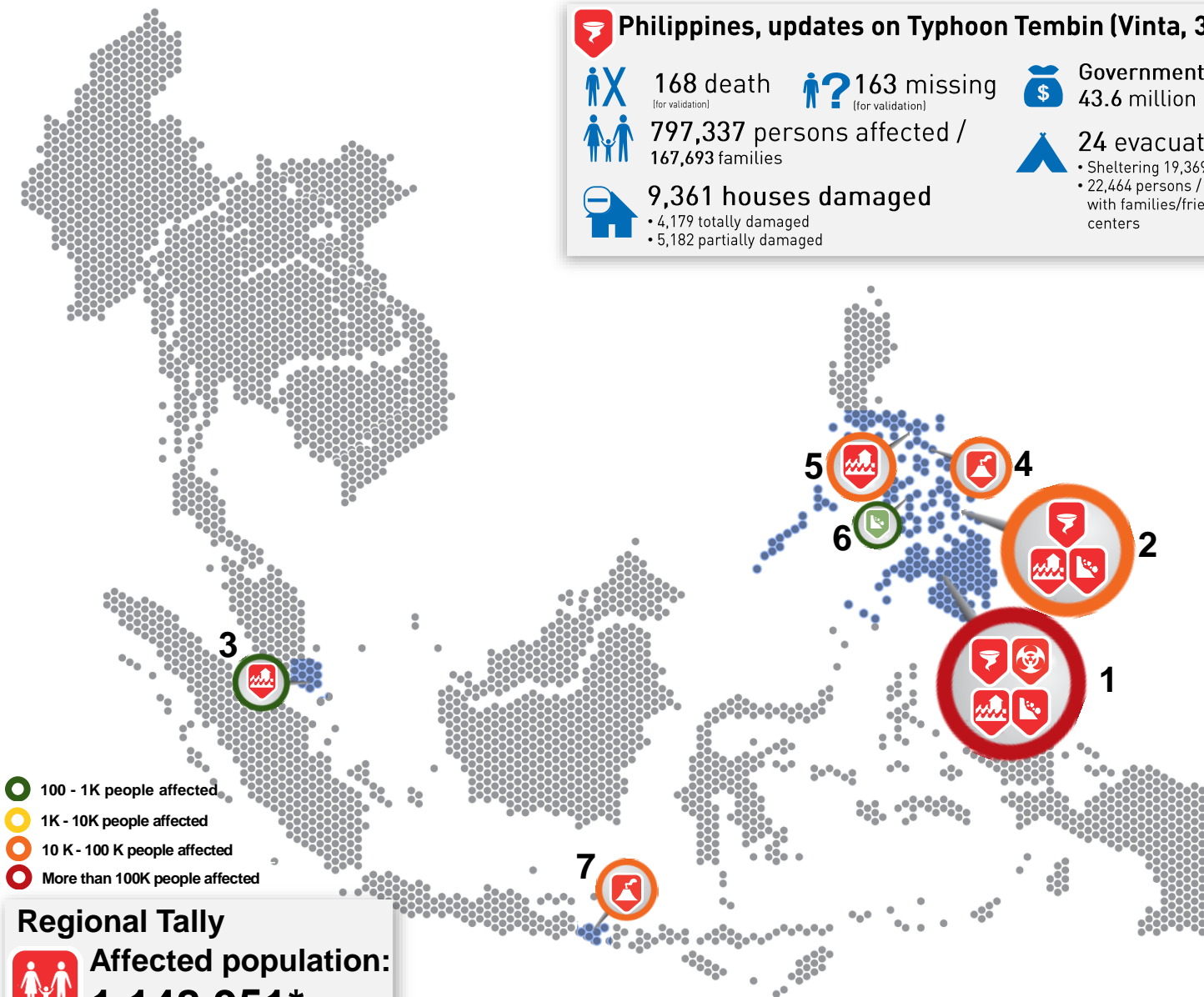

- 1) [PHIVOLCS-DOST](#) maintained Mt. Mayon's status at Alert Level 3 (high unrest and possible hazardous eruption) on 22-Jan-2018 08:00 UTC+8.
- 2) [NDRRMC](#) & [DSWD](#) reported 40,718 persons (10,491 families) in Albay Province are affected due to Mt. Mayon Phreatic Eruption.
