## Philippines, Albay Province, Mayon Volcano Phreatomagmatic Eruption update, 04 Feb 2018 ([NDRRMC](http://ndrrmc.gov.ph), [DSWD](http://dswd.gov.ph))

- 1) [PHIVOLCS-DOST](http://phivolcs-dost.deped.gov.ph) maintains Alert Level 4 for Mount Mayon (hazardous eruption imminent) and the 8-km Permanent Danger Zone (PDZ) remains effective
- 2) Sporadic and weak lava fountaining, lava flow and degassing from Mayon summit observed ([NDRRMC](http://ndrrmc.gov.ph))
- 3) Province of Albay, Region V was declared under the State of Calamity thru [Resolution No. 00670-2018](http://www.officialgazette.gov.ph/2018/01/23/resolution-no-00670-2018/)
- 4) AHA Centre is closely monitoring the situation
