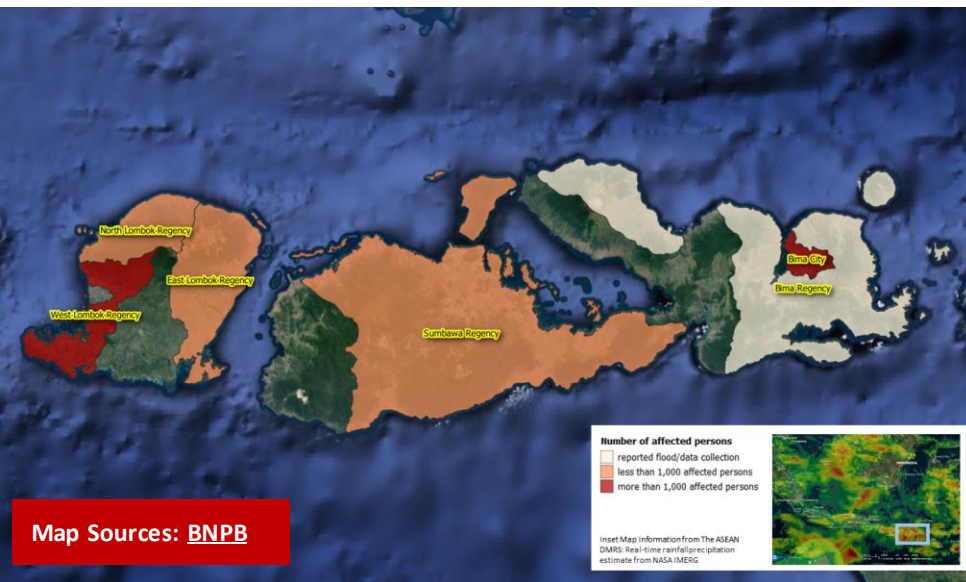


FLOODING AND LANDSLIDE IN WEST NUSA TENGGARA, INDONESIA FLASH UPDATE #1

- **OVERVIEW:** On 5-6 Dec 2021, disasters were reported in West Nusa Tenggara province. Extreme weather, high tides, and clogged drainages caused flooding in East Lombok Regency. High-intensity rainfall (West Lombok, Bima, and Sumbawa Regencies) and high-intensity rainfall that caused rivers to overflow (Bima City-Jatibaru and Kendo Rivers) caused flooding in the province. Flooding and landslides were also reported in North Lombok Regency due to high-intensity rainfall and unstable soil structure as reported by Indonesia's Badan Nasional Penanggulangan Bencana ([BNPB](#)).
- **IMPACTS:** Indonesia's [BNPB](#) has recorded the following:

- **RESPONSE:**
 1. **Assessment** - assessment underway in coordination with relevant agencies in Bima Regency, North Lombok Regency, Sumbawa Regency, and East Lombok Regency;
 2. **Data collection** - underway in West Lombok Regency and Bima City in coordination with local authorities;
 3. **Evacuation** - search and rescue underway in West Lombok Regency, Bima City, and North Lombok Regency with BPBD and volunteers;
 4. **Assistance** - Distributed in West Lombok by the BPBD;
 5. **Others** - clearing of clogged drainage underway in East Lombok Regency; BPBD Bima City have established a soup kitchen; BPBD Bima Regency conducting water suction using a pump.
- **URGENT NEEDS:** reports from BNPB and BPBD details urgents needs as follows: (1) West Lombok - blankets, tarpaulins, ready meals, baby clothes; (2) Sumbawa Regency - mineral water, instant noodles, tarpaulins, and sacks.
- **CURRENT CONDITIONS:** according to the [BNPB](#), floods in two-subdistricts of West Lombok have started to recede but flood in some areas persists; light rainfall has been reported in Bima City and Sumbawa.
- The AHA Centre will continue to monitor for further developments and issue necessary updates.
